

Website Privacy and Accessibility Policy

The privacy of our customers is important to the Homestead Medical Clinic. To ensure your privacy as a visitor to our website, "HOMESTEAD MEDICAL CLINIC" has the following policy:

Data Collection

You do not have to give us personal information to visit our sites. If you choose not to provide personal information, you can still visit most pages. We may collect personally identifiable information (name, e-mail address, physical address, and other unique identifiers) only if specifically and knowingly provided by you. Personally identifying information will be used only in as described at the point of collection.

By submitting personal information to Homestead Medical Clinic via our website, you are authorizing us to use the information. We use your information to respond to your inquiries and requests for materials, to register you for events and to place you in our employment pool. We may also use this information to keep you informed about our programs, news and other timely information. You always have the option to opt out of receiving communications from Homestead Medical Clinic, either via e-mail notification, in writing or by contacting us by phone. Homestead Medical Clinic may collect information from health care providers seeking to participate or participating in quality improvement programs funded by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), an agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. In such cases, Homestead Medical Clinic may be required to share that information with CMS. In all other cases, we do not disclose, give, sell or transfer any personal information to third parties. If we share demographic or other information with third parties, we will give them aggregate information only.

Some information collected is used to analyze use of our website and to help us improve our site. We do not use any of the information to identify or track individual visitors, nor do we sell or transmit any website tracking information to other parties.

Do we use cookies?

The term "cookie" describes a file that is saved on your computer's hard drive by a website. Cookies that stay on the hard drive and can be used after you end your session on a website are called "persistent cookies." Homestead Medical Clinic may and could use persistent

cookies. The term "session cookies" refers to temporary files that are used to enhance your visit to the website, and are deleted after you end the session. Homestead Medical Clinic may and could use session cookies, but they are not retained and they do not track personal information of any kind.
